## 2010 Growling Frog Ladies Golf Club Inc Charity Day Conditions of Entry

### 1. About

The Growling Frog Ladies' Charity Golf Day was first held in 2008 and raised money for research into children's cancer.

### 2. Competition Procedure

The Stableford system is used for this competition. However in 4BBB Stableford two players play as partners although the hole is played by each of them, using their individual full handicaps. At the completion of the hole, that player recording the highest number of points has her score entered on the card. If both partners score equally on the hole, the score of the player who first completed the hole will be recorded. There is no need to record both scores since only the best score is required.

The winner is determined by adding the scores for each nine holes and totalling for eighteen holes. The team with the most points is the winner. To speed up the game, it is customary practice for players to pick up their ball once it is impossible for them to better their partner's score.

In 4BBB Stableford, women use their own tees and scorecard conditions. It is not essential and only customary when marking the scorecard, for the marker to indicate or calculate the Stableford points scored by a player. However it is necessary that the number of strokes taken must always be shown for holes where points are scored.

### 3. Entries

- (a) The entrance fee is \$23.00 per competitor.
- (b) In the case of withdrawal, clubs are requested to contact the Growling Frog Ladies' Golf Club Inc. Captain, Margaret Marczuk on 9438 3771.
- (c) If entries exceed limit, the last names from clubs with several players will be declined in order of receipt. Refunds may not be given for withdrawals after the draw is completed.

### 5. Conditions of Competition

- (a) All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrews Scotland, subject to local rules that are in force at the course where the tournament is conducted.
- (b) All competitors will be required to provide proof of handicap prior to the commencement of play.
- (c) Any disputes and protests will be decided by the Growling Frog Ladies' Golf Club Inc Match Committee whose decision will be final.
- (d) A player with a disability and unable to play without the use of a motorized cart must obtain a Doctor's certificate.
- (e) Mobile Phones are only permitted for emergencies otherwise must be switched off. Unauthorised use of mobile phones will be considered a serious breach of etiquette.

Players are asked to arrive at the golf course at least 30 minutes prior to the stipulated tee time.
